

2022 MARKET ON MAIN STANDARDS

Dates & Hours of Operation

Preview day for vendors only - May 26, 2022 11:30 am to 12:30 pm (to locate your assigned space)

Opening day of Market - June 6, 2022 8:00 am to 11:00 am

Last day of Summer Market - August 27, 2022 8:00 am - 11:00 am

The Market opens at 8:00 am and ends at 11:00 am.

All vendors are required to be on the premises by 7:30 am and **remain until the market closes at 11:00 am.**

Vendors must commit to attending the market each weekend to maintain the consistency of the market experience for customers.

No sales are allowed until 8:00 am. This means that vendors CANNOT bag or sell merchandise before the official 8:00 am opening of the market.

Vendors are encouraged to follow sanitary hygiene practices at all times.

Physical distancing and hand sanitation practices are expected. No food sampling permitted.

Fees

An annual membership fee of \$25.00 is required. Make checks payable to the DLDA.

Guidelines

This market is promoted as a **locally sourced** produce market. This means that all products sold at the market must be locally grown on your property.

LOCAL is defined as Troup county and any of the counties that border Troup county (Heard, Coweta, Meriwether, Harris, Chambers, Randolph)

We will not permit produce from any other **source** to be sold at the market.

Vendors from outside the region may be permitted at the discretion of the market manager.

Handmade or value added agricultural products may be sold in addition to produce.

Examples are: cakes, canned goods, jellies, bread, soap, and plants.

Handcrafted items may be sold with the market manager's approval.

Examples are: Quilts, turned wood objects, stained glass, iron works, pottery, paintings, aprons, face masks.

No craft or flea market items allowed.

Vendors must supply copies of any applicable licenses from Georgia Department of Agriculture: Cottage Food, Egg Candling, Mobile meat. For more information - www.agr.georgia.gov

A member may make arrangements with the Market manager to sell for another market member should the need arise.
(Vacation or family emergency)

Positive interaction with customers is important for the success of the Market and vendors.

All sellers at the market are encouraged to be friendly, courteous, truthful and honest.

Produce and other items should be of good quality and pleasing in appearance.

Vendors should be neat and clean in appearance.

The market is a **smoke / vape free zone.**

You are responsible for leaving your area as you found it.
